

Family of murdered activist served demolition orders and attack on elderly couple in Umm al-Khair:

October 26 - residents were served final demolition orders including eleven family homes, agricultural and bathroom buildings and the Umm al-Khair community centre.

November 5 - settlers attacked an elderly couple and stole from their home.

Israeli settlers attack villagers in Al-Markaz:

November 20 - settlers armed with sticks and tear gas injured residents. They fractured a man's skull, broke his nose, and injured his son's head.

Israeli settlers assault elderly man in Wadi Rakhim:

November 21 - settlers attacked an 85-year-old man as he was riding his donkey to the mosque.

Israeli settlers terrorize residents in Shab al Batin:

December 5 - armed settlers pointed guns at residents and another tried to hit Palestinians with his ATV. Two Palestinians were arrested.

Israeli army raid Palestinian and internationals houses in Tuwani:

December 15 - army and police raided the homes of human rights activist Hafez Hureini and his neighbors. They also broke into an apartment where International solidarity activists were sleeping, assaulting one of them.

Israeli soldiers brutally assault amputee Shaikh Said in Rakiz:

December 15 - the Israeli army supported a settler in tearing down a fence to prevent settler sheep and ATVs trespassing. They stole Shaik Said's crutches, laughed as he screamed in pain, and then violently arrested him.

A QUARTERLY REPORT FROM THE GROUND OCTOBER - DECEMBER 2025

In the West Bank, Israeli authorities and colonizer leadership have engaged in **new legal and administrative** steps to consolidate de facto annexation by expanding **settlements**, restricting **Palestinian land access** and increasing **incursions**. They are openly attempting to **take control of areas under Palestinian control** and have declared intent to "expel Bedouins".

Meanwhile in Gaza, **Israel continues to carry out genocidal violence**. **Bombardment, displacement**, and the **systematic obstruction of aid** have worsened an already **catastrophic humanitarian crisis**, with civilian life and basic infrastructure pushed beyond collapse.





AL-MUGHAYYIR

Israeli settlers fatally poison sheep: November 22 - after a settler herded sheep near their home, the Abu Hamam family discovered four of their sheep had been poisoned.



Fire after settlers loot property - "The fire was not a choice, it was a cry... against the settlers and those behind them."

Armed settlers attack Palestinian family and internationals: December 7 - masked settlers armed with clubs attacked the Abu Hamam home, injuring two family members and four internationals, and threatening to burn the houses if they did not leave.

Palestinians resist displacement after looting by Israeli settlers: December 9 - settlers and soldiers looted an abandoned house prompting Palestinians and activists to burn remaining belongings in protest in resistance to theft, dispossession, and displacement.

AL KHALIL (HEBRON)

Israeli sniper murders young boy in Al-Rihiya: October 16 - Soldier caught on CCTV cheering after fatally shooting Muhammed Bahjat Al-Hallaq whilst he was playing.

Israeli settlers murder Palestinian truck driver: November 3 - a settler fatally shot Ahmed Rabhi Al-Atrash. He died at the scene after emergency crews were prevented from reaching him.

Soldiers kill, abduct and beat Palestinians in the Old City: December 6 - soldiers shot and killed Ahmad Khalil al Rajabi and Ziyad Naeem Abu Dawoud in Bab al Zawya. The army also abducted Mohammad al Karaky, who was released and hospitalized after being beaten unconscious, and beat another municipal worker.

OLIVE HARVEST: ZAYTOUN 2025

A resistance against Israeli colonisation and the restrictions around land access. Internationals joined Palestinians, supporting the harvest and documenting attacks and blockades.

Tear gas, drones and arson in Nazla al-Sharqiya: October 15 - Border Police fired tear gas at Palestinians and international activists. The army attacked them with drones and more tear gas which set the olive groves on fire. They injured multiple people.

Israeli settlers attack Palestinians and solidarity activists in Kufr Ra'i: October 17 - Israeli soldiers fired tear gas at olive harvesters. Whilst they were retreating, fifteen masked settlers attacked them. They injured two men and a woman suffocated due to the tear gas.

Israeli army arrest farmers and beat journalist in Ramin: October 17 - an armed Israeli settler forced Palestinian farmers and solidarity activists to leave the harvest. The army blocked their vehicle then detained the farmers, two journalists, and solidarity activists. They arrested the Palestinian farmers and one journalist, and broke the journalist's wrist.

Israeli army forcibly halts harvest in Sa'ir: October 23 - the Israeli army declared the Palestinian olive groves a "Closed Military Zone" and forcibly removed harvesters.

Armed settler dog attack and robbery in Jourish: October 27 - settlers armed with clubs and accompanied by an attack dog assaulted farmers, injuring at least one Palestinian.

Settlers bludgeon woman in Turmusayya: October 19 - a settler attacked Umm Saleh with a wooden bat, causing an intracranial haemorrhage. They also struck an international activist, injured others and set fire to vehicles whilst the Israeli army watched.

Israeli settlers destroy olive trees in Al Mughayyir: October 12 - settlers felled approx 150 olive trees in Marj Sia. During this time, they were destroying olive trees daily.

Israeli soldiers kill 13-year-old Ayssam Jihad Ma'ala in Beita: October 11 - the Israeli army attacked olive harvesters with tear gas, suffocating Ayssam Jihad Ma'ala and causing brain damage which left him comatose. On November 11 Ayssam died.



JORDAN VALLEY

Settler security drives truck into Palestinian woman in Farsiya: October 19 - Shai drove his truck into a Palestinian woman whilst she was shepherding. He returned with the police who interrogated internationals and the woman.

Army attack family in Al Makhul: October 24 - Israeli army raided the family's home, tying up, blindfolding, and beating the father.

Israel arrest human rights activist in Fasiyal: November 17 - Israel arrested Ayman Gh-rayeb, disappeared him and denied him contact with his lawyer. They beat him so severely he required hospitalization. After a month in custody, he was sentenced to 6 months in administrative detention.



Displacement, lockdowns and raids in Tubas: Israel is planning a 22km road barrier and apartheid wall from Ein Shibli to Tayasir checkpoint.

October - Israeli settlers and the army displaced Abu Bahaa's family, the last remaining family in Ibziq.

November 25-29 - the Israeli army locked down Tubas, opened fire at anyone attempting to leave their homes, raided approx 350 homes, injured 166 Palestinians and killed one.

Destruction and assault in Al Hadidya: December 1 - the Israeli army made two homes military posts, demolished one and damaged others and a supermarket.

October 8 - settlers destroyed the family's tractor, water, solar panels, and car. They also attacked the grandmother.

December 18 - settlers raided homes, assaulting Palestinians and their livestock. The army then arrested three Palestinians.

Settlers kill dog and rob sheep in Khirbet Humsa: October 24 - settlers killed a family's dog then tried to steal their sheep.

Displacement and vandalism in Fasiyal Al Wusta: November 6 - settlers forcibly displaced five families, leaving just one remaining. Settlers also built a fence around their property and cut their water pipeline.

November 9 - Israel's Nature & Parks Authority killed multiple dogs belonging to Palestinians.
